

CAMP MA-KA-JA-WAN INFORMATION

TROOP 156 SUMMER 2010

MA-KA-JA-WAN Scout Reservation is located on 1500 acres, 25 miles northeast of Antigo, Wisconsin.
Troop 156 attends as a group during Council weeks five and six of the camp season.

(All adults permitted to attend camp need to be fully TRAINED under the BSA standards and will be selected by the Troop Committee/SM/ASM corps.)

Registration and Non-Refundable Deposit: The deposit of \$50.00 per Scout, per week is due by February 24, 2010. Balance of fees is due May 5, 2010 or a \$35 late fee is required by Council. There is also a \$15 late fee charged for bus reservations made 2 weeks before the session.

MORE DETAILS:

- Registration is on a first come, first served basis.
- Boys who are entering the 6th grade as of September 2010 will be allowed to attend one week of camp provided they have attended a least one regular weekend Troop 156 campout.
- Should a week be over-subscribed, placement will be made based on criteria set by the Scoutmaster.
- Eligibility requirements for camp are based on participation in the Troop including meeting attendance, uniform, service projects, and behavior.
- Final commitment for bus transportation will be required with the final payment in May.
- If a Scout is not taking the bus, they must arrive at Camp between 1:00 and 4:00 PM on Sunday and be picked up between 9:00 and 10:00 AM on Saturday.

High Adventure Programs: These include Flambeau Flowage Canoe Trek, Sylvania Wilderness Adventure (fishing), and Porcupine Mountains Backpacking. These trips are intended for First Class Scouts who are at least 13 years old and subject to adult leader availability. The Council requires an extra charge for high adventure activities. Please indicate any interest in these programs on your registration form.

Fine print reminders:

If this is the first time you've gone to a Boy Scout summer camp, you are limited to one week at Camp MaKaJaWan. Troop 156 expects summer campers to be active members who have attended at least one regular season Troop 156 campout to qualify for MaKaJaWan.

*Each camper must provide three signed copies of the **NEW BSA Medical Form** (which requires an annual physical) along with copies of your insurance card (front & back) for each camper. These are required no later than the final payment on May 5, 2010. Youth and adult leaders are now both covered by the same medical form which can be found on the Troop 156 website at www.bsa156.org or at www.neic.org.*

Trained adult leaders will attend camp each week and must also submit an annual Medical Form. Troop policy limits the number of adults in camp and final selection of those attending is made by the Scoutmaster. For more information go to www.bsa156.org and click on forms.

The Troop must provide an adult to ride the Council bus or we cannot use the bus service. If you are an attending adult leader, please consider volunteering to ride the bus up to or back from Camp MaKaJaWan. We will help you coordinate transportation for the other direction of the trip. Depending on the number of registrations, it may also be feasible to arrange alternate transportation with parents who plan to drive.
